## **Oral Presentation Guidelines**

Oral presentations during the general sessions will be limited to a 20 minute time slot. We recommend limiting your presentation to 15 to 18 minutes to allow for questions. If you have been asked by Utah AFS to present during the plenary session, your presentations will be limited to 30 minutes.

## **Poster Presentation Guidelines**

Please restrict your poster to a maximum size of 3' high (0.92 m) x 4' wide (1.22 m) and have a smooth finish. Poster boards will be provided. Posters can be attached to the boards with double-sided adhesive strips or hook and loop (VELCRO<sup>®</sup>) type fasteners. If using VELCRO<sup>®</sup>, provide both sides (adhesive backing will be required). You are responsible for providing your own form of attachment.

We are still working on our 2019 meeting details, so there will be more to come regarding additional registration information and deadlines, awards and deadlines, and continuing education.
